
OFFLU SIV group objectives

- Identify appropriate diagnostic/research tests
- Provide recommended testing algorithms

Action Items

- Publication of lists of viruses and diagnostic tests, and testing algorithms
- Write and publish SIV Group publication of network's statement
- Publish a paper on SIV Review and OFFLU activities surveillance
