

## OFFLU wildlife technical activity

## Updated terms of reference (October 2024):

- 1. To provide a global platform for discussion, coordination, and data-sharing between key wildlife experts involved in influenza monitoring, management and research.
- 2. To provide early warning to stakeholders of emerging threats of influenza involving wildlife.
- 3. To provide OFFLU with technical expertise on influenza in wildlife.
- 4. To respond to specific technical requests on influenza involving wildlife.
- 5. To provide technical guidance to stakeholders on monitoring, management and research on influenza involving wildlife.
- 6. To proactively engage with other OFFLU groups and committees, ensuring the One Health approach.
- 7. To regularly review OFFLU's guidance on monitoring, management and research priorities on influenza in wildlife.
- 8. To provide advice on preventing transmission of influenza from domestic and farmed animals and humans into wildlife and so protect wildlife health.
- 9. To provide technical guidance on managing influenza in such a way as to minimize detrimental impact on biodiversity and to maximize benefits to biodiversity.
